Many migrated to North America where they they were rebuilt with more powerful engines and a range of modifications to enhance performance, just like the Grumman Widgeons.

As G-44A Widgeon production was ending at Grumman's factory at Bethpage NY in 1947, negotiations commenced with the French concern **Societe de Constructions AeroNavales de Port-Neuf (SCAN)** to allow licenced production of the type for the European market. The manufacturing licence agreement was completed in 1948, when tooling, components and construction data was sent to France.

The French manufacturer had been building SCAN 20 flying boat trainers for the French Navy but their factory near La Rochelle was destroyed during WWII. Rebuilding by the French Government was completed in 1948 and post-war optimism was reflected by the company's decision to build a prortype then a production run of 41 aircraft.

Differences from the Grumman design were confined to engine installations, instrument panel and strengthening of the hull structure. The dimensions of airframe components were changed to the nearest metric equivalent.

Construction had begun by April 1948. That same month tragedy struck when SCAN founder Leon Douzille was killed when a visiting US Widgeon NC86644 struck a mountain in Spain while taking him to La Rochelle.

Designated simply as SCAN-30, the aircraft was marketed offering the following models:

- SCAN 30: 190hp Mathis 8G40 eight cylinder engines
- SCAN 30A: 240hp Salmson 8 AS-00 eight cylinder inverted vee engines
- SCAN 30G: 200hp de Havilland Gipsy Queen II six cylinder in-line engines
- SCAN 30L: 260hp Lycoming GO-435-C2 flat-six engines

The prototype SCAN 30 was test flown in January 1949 but early sales were not helped by the loss of this first aircraft six months later, when it crashed into the River Seine during an enthusiastic demonstration flight for a group of prospective buyers. The small company's hopes were further dashed when the French Navy failed to place an expected order and civil sales were slow. These factors, combined with delays in delivery of the Lycoming engines from USA resulted in the remaining aircraft on the production line being inspected by the French airworthiness authority Bureau Veritas in December 1949, after which most went into long-term storage.

By 1952 few aircraft had sold and the only prospective sales were to French colonial government agencies. Late that year the French Government put most of the 33 uncompleted airframes up for auction at La Rochel. 20 were purchased by Intercontinental Aviation, managed by Alan H. Stansted, an associate company of Californian aviation entrepreneur Lee Mansdorf.

In February 1953 a total of 29 incomplete SCAN 30s purchased by North American owners were packed and loaded on board the ship *Cape Rodney* bound for Los Angeles. Ownership of 20 was transferred to a Canadian company Conair Corp, Montreal, Quebec before all being on-sold to Lee Mansdorf & Co, California in 1954. Another Mansdorf associate company, Pacific Aircraft Engineering Co marketed these aircraft under the names **PACE Gannet** and **Gannet Super Widgeon** with a choice of 220hp Continental W-670 radials, 260hp Lycoming GO-435 flat six engines, or 300 hp Lycoming R-680-E3 nine cylinder radials.
