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**CHANCE VOUGHT F4U & GOODYEAR FG-1D CORSAIR**  
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*Identities of the F4Us recovered from Fuerza Aerea Hondurena by US warbird enthusiasts in the 1970s  
 have become confused and contradictory. Links between BuAer number to FAH serial toN number,  
 given FAH military rebuilds and civil composite rebuilds using components from various aircraft, have  
 made definitive identities difficult to substantiate.  
 FAH Corsairs are listed below as my best interpretation of conflicting data over the past thirty years.*
